HERE'S THE LESSON PLAN.

As a driver you have a responsibility to park in a safe and considerate manner, if you don't you could be endangering a child's life. Please park with care, and help make the area near and around your child's school a safer place for the pupils.

Revision Tips:

If you need to drive your child to school, for their safety, please remember:

- No parking on double and single yellow lines
- No double parking
- No stopping, dropping off or parking on the school's yellow zig zag lines or white pedestrian crossing zig zag lines
- No parking on corners or junctions especially near the school entrance
- Please do not block driveways

Learning goals:

You don't always need to drive right up to the gates.
Why not try:

- Parking 5/10 minutes away from the school and letting your child walk the rest of the way
- Sharing the school run with other drivers with similar routes

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
